Alexandra Grimal, soloist prize in the "Tremplin L'Esprit Jazz 2008", first prize in Avignon «Grand Prix du Tremplin Européen de Jazz 2007» with her band «Alexandra Grimal Quartet», third prize with the same band in the «Concours National de Jazz de La Défense, Paris 2007» and winner with congratulations of the judges in the International Jazz Contest for Young Jazz Soloists, Fribourg 2007 (Switzerland) under the presidency of Martial Solal- explores new areas and works with such artists as Nelson Veras, Édouard Ferlet, Dré Pallemaerts, Manolo Cabras, Jean-Jacques Avenel, John Betsch...

Her musical research ranging from traditional to free jazz, including rock, experimental and original compositions was supported by grants awarded by the Paris Council after her recording of «Les 43 couchers de soleil» with the drummer Toma Gouband, as well as by the Socrates Exchange Programme which enabled her to study at the Sibelius Academy in Helsinki (Finland 2003).

She is an artist in residence at the «Studio des Variétés» (Paris october 2007) for the creation of «Respire» co-produced by «Les Jeunesses Musicales de France». She was also an artist in residence at the jazz club «La Fontaine» in Paris (2005-2006) and at the Banff Center for the Arts (2006).

Born in Cairo in 1980, Alexandra Grimal started music at the age of 5 with classical piano. At 15, in Paris, she was introduced to the saxophone. She received her master's degree at the Royal Conservatory of The Hague (the Netherlands) in 2005 under the direction of John Ruocco. She has also been a student in the «Conservatoire National Supérieur de Paris» (CNSM) and in the Sibelius Academy of Helsinki (Finland), with the Socrates Exchange Programme. She attended the Banff Workshop in Jazz and Creative Music 2007 under the guidance of Dave Douglas.

In different bands, clubs and festivals Alexandra has played in Belgium, France, Italy (Sardinia), Portugal, Germany, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and Finland.
